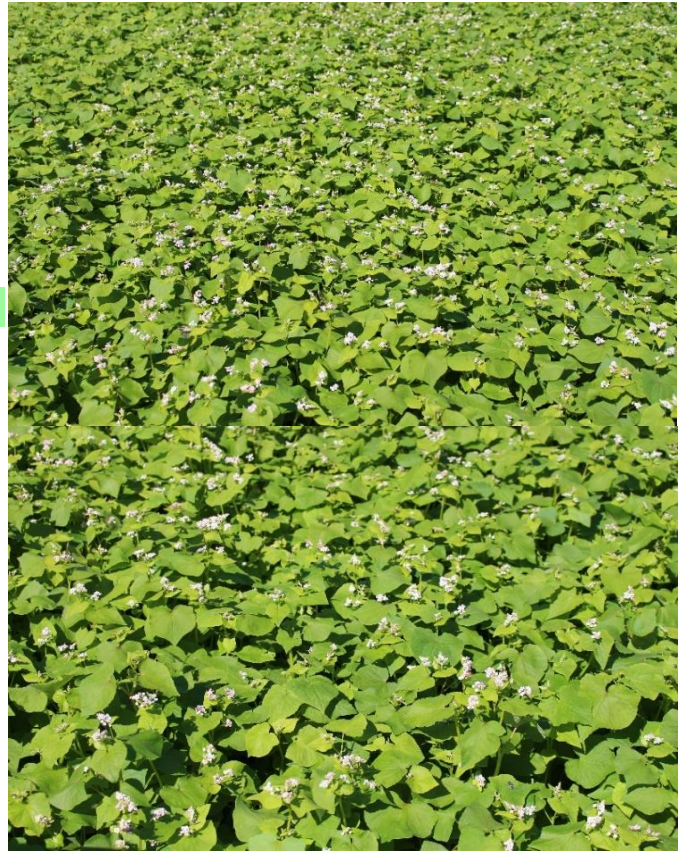

Species	Buckwheat
Botanical name	Fagopyrum esculentum
Seeding rate	75–90 kg/ha
Distance between rows	as cereals
Sowing period	May to August
Sowing depth	2–4 cm

Variety description

LILEJA is a fast-growing, undemanding variety that is also extremely robust and versatile. It is characterised by exceptional purity and high germination capacity. LILEJA can bind large amounts of nitrate and is winterkilled. It fits into almost any crop rotation, establishes soil contact very quickly and thus effectively suppresses weeds. As a cash crop, LILEJA can also deliver high grain yields. Its high thousand grain weight ensures excellent flour yields.
