Seeding rate	25–30 kg/ha as catch crop
Distance between rows	as cereals
Sowing period	from July to late August
Sowing depth	2–3 cm

Variety description

The variety was approved with grade 1 due to its tremendous nematode-reducing characteristics. Apart from this important property, REBELLION KWS is characterised by rapid early development, which quickly produces a dense and weed-suppressing stock. Furthermore, REBELLION KWS is very stable. Due to its late flowering, REBELLION KWS is recommended for growing as catch crop.

Most important characteristics

Outstanding resistance to beet cyst nematode, grade 1
Very low inclination to flower, despite extremely high mass development after sowing
Excellent weed suppression
Low tendency to lodging
