Variety description

FINOLA is a medium-late maturing hemp variety which is mainly used for grain production. Meanwhile, it only creates small amounts of straw, which makes the grain harvest considerably easier. Like in all hemp varieties used for this purpose, the THC content of FINOLA lies below 0.2%. Because of its good CBD content, FINOLA can also be used for industrial exploitation of the substance.
