### Variety description

VERMILLION is a French lawn grass variety of the highest grade. VERMILLION is tested in France and classified as having excellent characteristics. Its special features include in particular quick stand establishment and outstanding hard-weariness. Since 2021 VERMILLION is also successfully listed in the German RSM. VERMILLION is best suited for hard-wearing and recreational lawns. At the same time, it also shows low susceptibility to diseases and is a perfect component in mixtures owing to its medium green leaf colouration.
