## Variety description

SC1 is a new tall fescue variety, characterised in particular by its dark green leaves. The speciality here is that this colour remains green even throughout winter. SC1 also exhibits quick growth in spring and is extremely resilient. This makes it ideal for recreational and hard-wearing lawns. High resistance to diseases is another major advantage of this variety. SC1 is also characterized by a strong formation of runners. As a result, SC1 can establish very well even in established swards. SC1 is suitable for all types of lawns thanks to its rating and good tolerance of shade.
