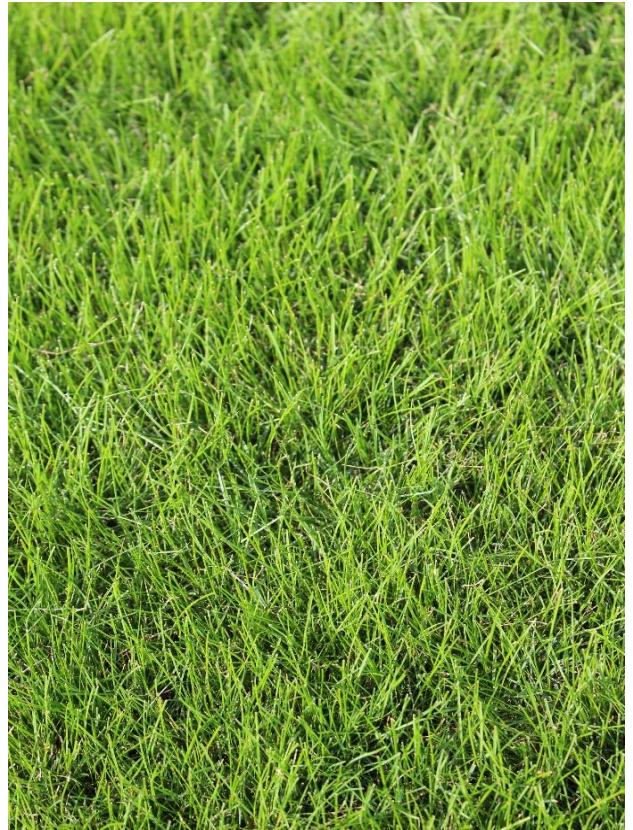

Variety description

GREENFIELD COM is a Chewing's fescue that quickly establishes a plant stand and produces a highly dense sward. This results in overall good weed suppression and almost weed-free cultivation. Another important characteristic of GREENFIELD COM is its rich, dark green colouration. The variety also tolerates deep cutting well. Therefore, it can be used very flexibly – from ornamental lawns and recreational lawns to sports lawns. Resistance to diseases rounds off the list of valuable qualities of this premium cultivar.
