## Variety description

Bred in the US and listed in 2021, GREENSPAN is a highly versatile tall fescue variety. Its dark-green leaves and medium resistance to brown patch, a lawn disease, make it a popular choice in home gardens as well as professional applications such as golf courses and hard-wearing sport fields. Its good quality characteristics are reflected in its high sward density and persistence, as well as a strong overall appearance.

## Most important characteristics

Good suitability for recreational and hard-wearing lawns  
Very fine leaves and dense sward  
Strong overall appearance  
High tolerance of shade and drought

## Remarks

Tall fescue forms strong, persistent clumps, some with underground shoots. It is deep-rooted and well-suited for use in very dry locations. Tall fescue can also adapt well to wet and shady areas.
